Next week we officially launch our **One School, One Book** program. In our school, we have actually selected two books to make them more age appropriate for our students. For the upcoming school year, students who turn 5 between September 2nd and February 2nd are eligible to enroll in TK. Additional information about the registration progress will be sent by the district shortly.
